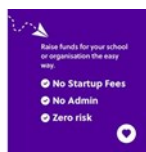
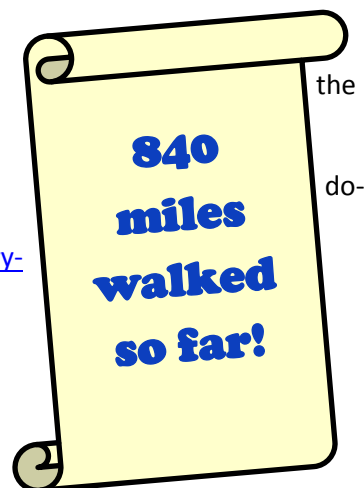
The children have been designing their own Christmas cards and thank you to them all for their amazing designs.
