

In **Reading** we will be...

- Reading our topic stories together to explore ourselves and the world around us.
- Identify sentence structures in the books, learning about different word types and find them in the text.
- Using our phonics and spelling rules to read new words
- Showing our understanding of how an author uses words and language to make a story interesting.
- Learning the meaning of new words.
- Reading instructions and non-fiction texts.

In **Writing** we will be...

- Using the stories to help us with writing ideas.
- Beginning our writing journey using different word types (nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs).
- Understand how to structure simple sentence and how to use words to expand longer sentences.
- Learning the key features of instruction writing and letter writing.
- Using our phonics and spelling rules in our writing.
- Practising our handwriting to form letters correctly and begin to make appropriate joins.
- Check our writing for capital letters and full stops.

As part of our topic we will include some **Geography** skills:

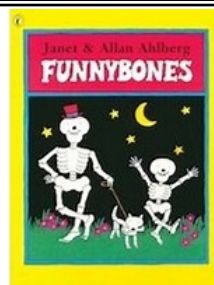
- Looking at the weather patterns for Autumn and Winter as we learn about seasonal changes.

As part of our topic we will include some **History** skills:

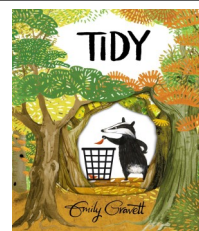
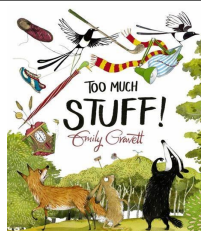
- Learning about Elizabeth Garrett Anderson.
